

Bernice Cohen Sachs, M.D. Endowed
Fund for Women Medical Students
Academic Scholarships



The Bernice Cohen Sachs, M.D. Endowed Fund for Women Medical Students will award academic scholarships up to \$3000 each to women medical students for the academic year 2010-2011. The awards will be based on financial need and demonstrated community involvement during undergraduate and/or medical school years.

Eligibility:

To be eligible for this scholarship, the applicant must:

1. Be a woman enrolled or applying for enrollment in medical school.
2. Be a staff member of Group Health Cooperative or one of its affiliates, a child of a staff member, a Group Health enrollee, or a child or grandchild of a Group Health enrollee.
3. Demonstrate financial need.
4. Demonstrate involvement in the community.

Application Process:

To apply for this scholarship, please submit the following materials to the address at the bottom of the page:

1. The Group Health scholarship application
2. A letter describing your personal situation, need for financial assistance, your community involvement and your career goals. (250 words, 1 page typed)
3. Two letters of recommendation from someone outside your family who has known you for at least two years, or who can speak to your career potential and/or your community involvement. (Must be typed)
4. If currently attending school, please submit a copy of your transcript. Otherwise, please submit a transcript from your most recently completed schooling.
5. Enclose a stamped, self-addressed (home address), business size (#10) envelope.

NOTE: Omission of any of the above information will eliminate your application from consideration.

A selection committee will determine and notify the Scholarship winners in July 2010.

These scholarships are for tuition, lab fees and books. In August 2010, checks will be mailed directly to the recipient's school of choice.
